Sometimes your photos may not be exactly what you want. We can crop or improve your photos as you desire.

cover design

After consulting with you, we can create options for your cover, including the spine and front and back covers.

publication & publishing management

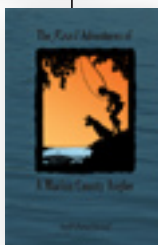


99 Voices, 99 Lives, a book of poetry by John Thompson, won the Finch and Rose Poetry Prize in 2006.

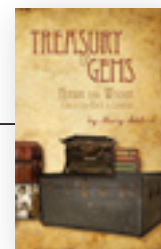
Health and Humor, by Charles Schafer, MD, proves that a health reference book can be written with humor and fun to read.
